Courses

- All courses at the Department of Economics are 10 or 15 ECTS
- Incoming exchange students to the Department are free to take courses at other Departments and Faculties.
- Exchange students at the master level are <u>not</u> able the register for master courses in the online portal (StudentWeb). Master student must therefore contact SV-info after they have received their admission letter in order to be registered for the courses by the Department which will evaluate if the students meet the required prerequisites for each course.
- Note that we can only evaluate the prerequisites if the students have uploaded a transcript of records in English.
