Admissions Requirements for Fall/Spring Programs

Students must upload the following items in their application:

Transcripts

Minimum GPA - 3.0 out of 4.0

Statement of Purpose

Proof of English Language Proficiency

TOEFL - 90 (at home test accepted)

IELTS- 7

DAAD- C1

TEM-4 or TEM -8 70

Cambridge C1 advanced

Duolingo 115

*English language requirement waivers available, per below

**Students without a test score can request an English language assessment, per below

Resume (Professional Certificate applicants only)

International students seeking an F-1 visa must also upload:

1. Copy of Passport
2. Bank Statement
3. Financial Certification Form

*A waiver for the English proficiency requirement can be made in the following circumstances:

1. One year of full-time university level instruction entirely in the English language
2. Successful completion of a university-level program in a country where English is the official language
3. [The student is from a country on the exempt list](#)

Transcripts and credentials should reflect any programs that the student completed entirely in English. Our admissions committee will assess all documentation and inform students if additional items are needed (E.g. Interview, test score, letter, etc.).

**Instructions to Request an English-Language Assessment

If a student does not meet any of the above criteria they have the opportunity to undergo an English-Language assessment through our department. If you are interested in this option students must select, "I would like to request an English interview" in their application.
